### Methodology

**Interactive discussions with the client organisation** CIID's methodology for infrastructure development begins with interactive discussions with the client organisation – usually the government ministry, department or agency responsible for the infrastructure sector. Based on these discussions, we put together an integrated programme to deliver the outcomes specified by the client organisation.

We engage with the client organisation – government ministry, department or agency; or private sector organisation – at all stages of the project, from concept to funding, procurement, implementation and ongoing management.

**Expert team** We create a team that addresses the needs and challenges identified by the client organisation, and designed to accomplish the required goals. The expert team conducts a project evaluation exercise and where required a detailed business case report. We work with the client organisation for project implementation, procurement and management support, including contract management where required, at all stages of the project, focusing on introducing international standards of best practice.

Our teams include specialist technical experts, with relevant high level experience in the sector; infrastructure project funding specialists, including PPP experts; and capacity building and skills development professionals.

**Capacity building and skills training** We provide capacity building, including customised training for management and technical specialists; and skills training for the work force. Where required, these programmes can lead to accredited qualifications. We often commence the process with short interactive workshops with key selected participants from the client organisation, to build the most effective programme for project implementation.

**Project funding** We provide expert advice to create the most appropriate funding and financing structures, including PPP. We assist in arranging sources of funding and financing.
